

## SYNERGX SYSTEMS INC. (NASDAQ SMALL CAP-SYNX) ANNOUNCES NEW CONTRACTS

Synergx announces that its Casey Systems subsidiary has secured a contract to provide a public address system to a new passenger cruise ship terminal on the Westside of Manhattan.
